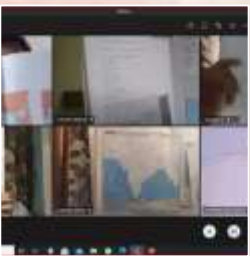
Mathematics Activity done by class XII C on the topic Relations and Functions.

Class XII had conducted an Assembly on Earth Day i.e. on 22.4.2021




