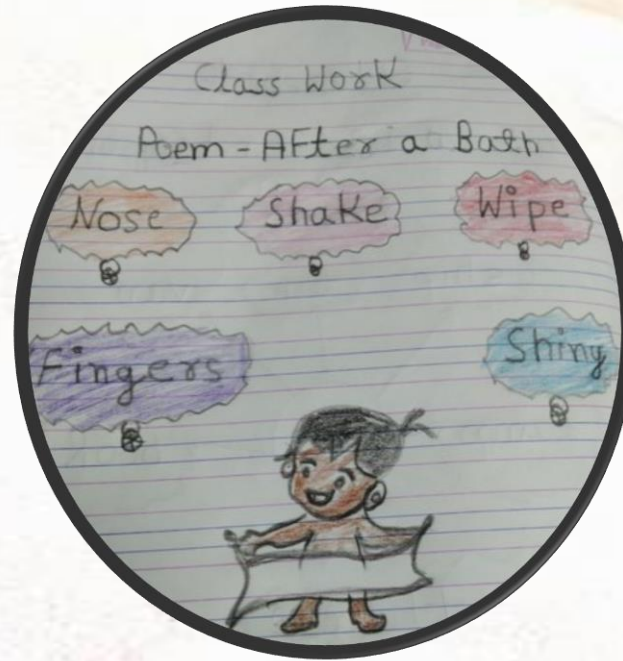

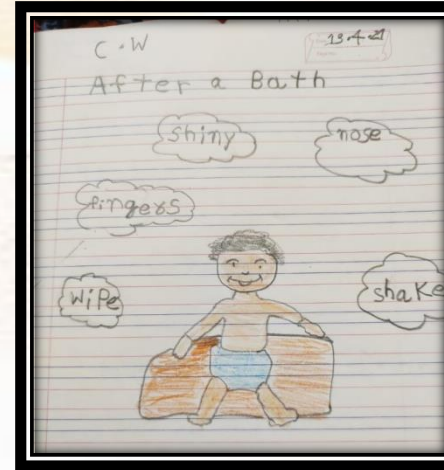
To develop their vocabulary students learnt new words from a poem 'After a Bath'. They even wrote the words in their notebooks and drew beautiful pictures.
