*** BAHUJAN SAMAJ PARTY :**

- The BSP was founded in 1984 by Kanshi Ram. The party consists of lower caste groups like SC, ST or OBC. The party also believe in egalitarianism and hold a strong emphasis on social justice.
- SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS :
- The election symbol of the BSP is an "Elephant" which symbolized - It is tough, fearless, peaceful as well as full of strength.
- A number of schemes or Yojnas initiated in UP have helped poor families. Like "Uttari Pradash Mukhyanabi Chhajib Arthik Madad Yojna", "Dr. Ambedkar Gram Sabha Samagra Vikas Yojna", "Mansukh Bahi Karamjoshi Shiksha Chhajib Awas Yojna", etc.
- These schemes have made possible the families of the BPL list to get free education, housing and other assistance from BSP.

ANVI BISHT X-A

When it became the second largest party after the 2014 Delhi Legislative Assembly election and formed the government with the JDU, which just lasted for 10 days and did not even get a majority after the Lok Sabha election. It was defeated in the assembly but, BSP formed the government in 2011 elections, becoming the largest party, winning 50% of the seats, resulting in a state and pushing Congress out of power. Since 2011, BSP has seen a lot of changes in every aspect. The first was a check on school fees of private schools and didn't allow schools to take fee. Second was supporting the government schools. The BSP government started 20,000 classrooms against 1000 government schools but only the quantity increased, the quality increased by standards and made it to the international level.

The students were asked to choose a favourite picture of your father and make a digital card for him.



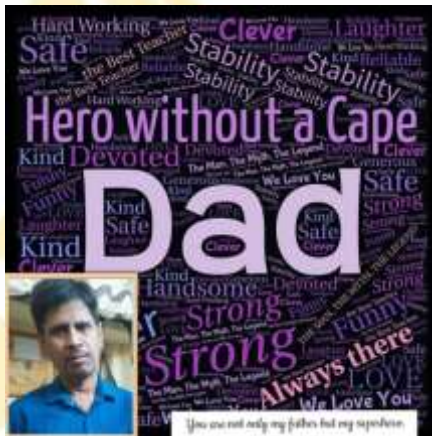
