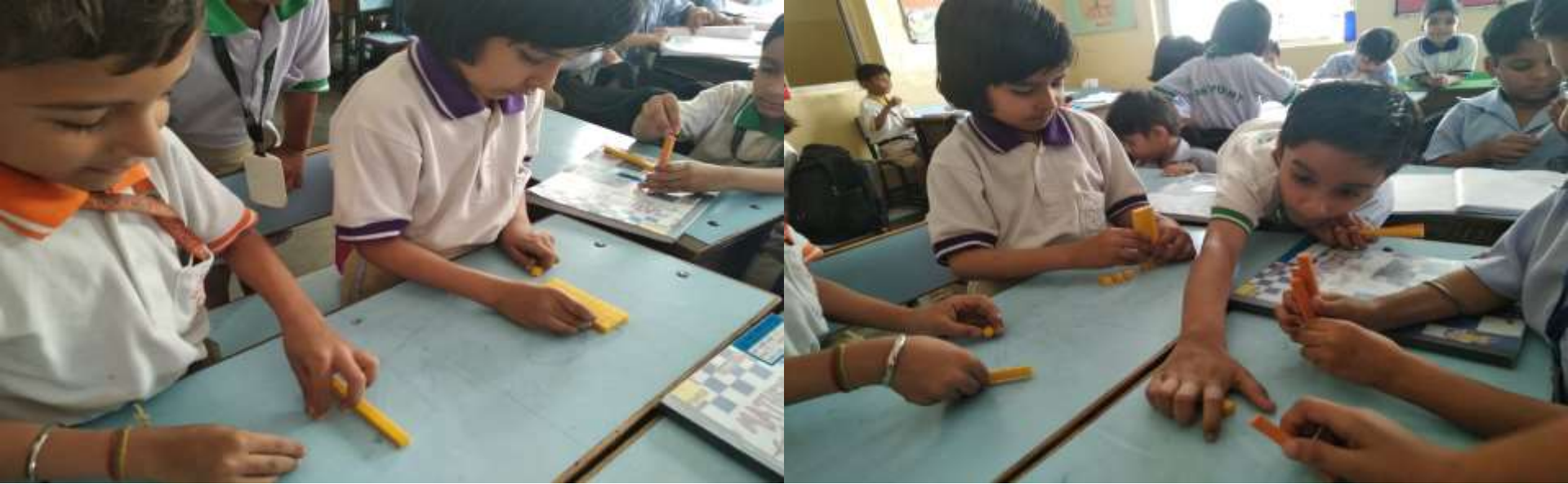

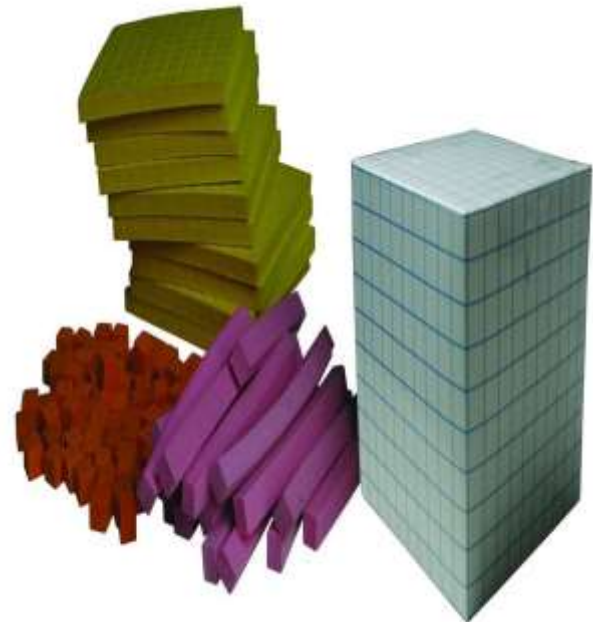

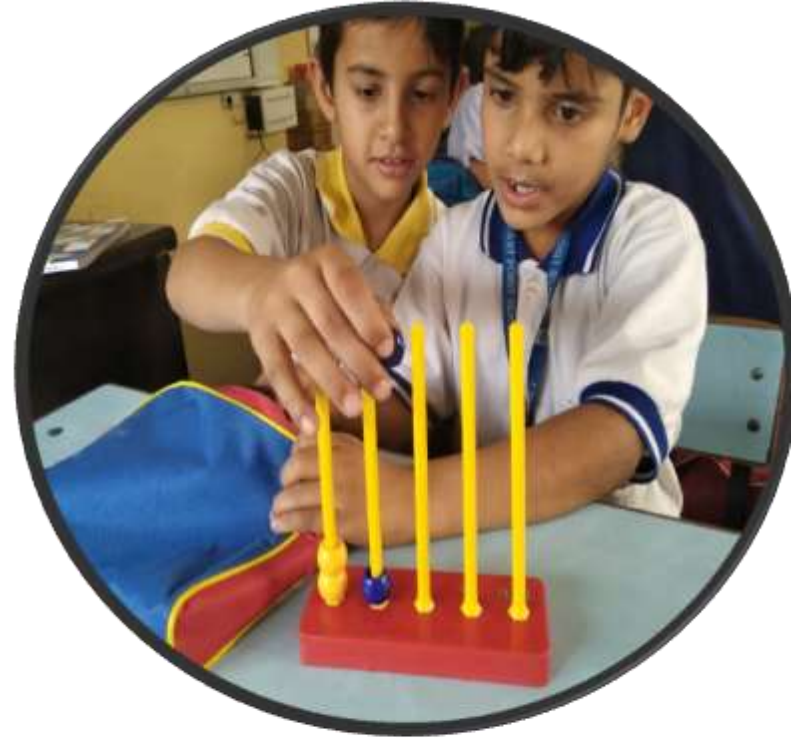
Maths Activity

Dienes block activity was conducted in class, to enable children to make bundles of tens and form 2 digit numbers. This activity helped students physically represent what they're learning so they can develop a deeper understanding of the meaning of each concept. By building number combinations with Base Ten Blocks, students easily grasped the concept of regrouping .



Abacus activity

Children used abacus to understand place and place value of each digit in a 3 digit number. Later they used bindi to represent abacus in their notebooks. This activity helped the students to improve their concentration skills.



Paper bag activity

Making of paper bag activity was conducted in the class. Students were encouraged to use paper bags in place of plastic bags. They were also asked to spread the same message in their neighbourhood.
