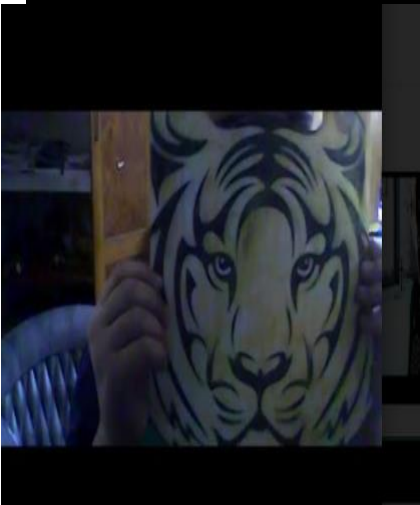
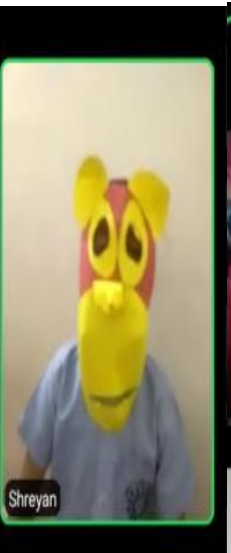
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Students actively participated in “DECLAMATION” Activity wherein they talked about the Pros and Cons of Endangered animals found in the Coastal region.

Students were asked to make travel brochure as an activity for Country of the month.



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Inventions & Contributions
